CONTEST DETAILS

To enter the **2010 Quebec Trip Contest**, eligible students* must create a PowerPoint presentation detailing their experience travelling to Quebec, and email it to cpfnorthvan@gmail.com by January 15, 2011. Presentations should promote the benefits of a trip to Quebec and the cultural diversity of the province. Let us know why other French students should visit Quebec!

PowerPoint Presentation Rules:

- Must be in French
- Minimum of 10 slides, maximum of 25 slides
- The majority of photographs in the presentation should have been taken during your trip.
- Title slide should list student name(s), trip dates, and the name of the NVSD school you were attending at time of travel
- Presentation should include: where you stayed, places you visited, 3 educational venues
- You may embed video in the presentation, but it must be your own.
- Last slide should be a bibliography, please reference all material used in presentation
- Please note that students may enter the contest/create presentations in groups, but only one person can be nominated as cheque payee.

Eligibility Requirements*:

The 2010 Quebec Trip Contest is open to North Vancouver School District grade 6-12 students, currently registered in a French program (Core French or French Immersion). Contest entrants are required to have visited Quebec in the past 4 years, and to have been a NVSD student at time of travel.

Winning Entries:

A panel of CPF members will determine the winners by March 15, 2011. The winning entries may be used by CPF to promote future school trips to Quebec, and will be displayed on the CPF/North Vancouver website, www.cpf.bc.ca/northvan.
